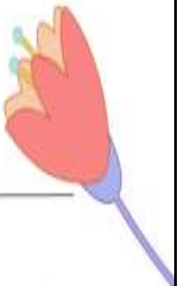


Tuesday 7th July

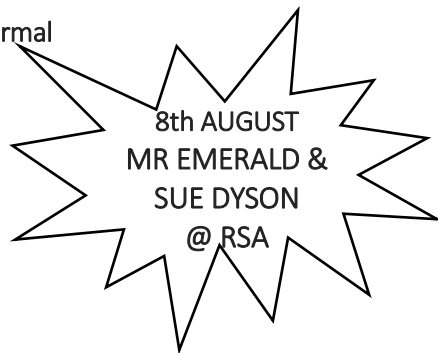

ACCESSING HEALTH SERVICES

GOLDEN RULES FOR ALERT LEVEL 1

While the risk of exposure to COVID-19 is now low, there are some Golden Rules we should all follow to help prevent future spread.

1. If you're sick, stay home. Don't go to work or school. Don't socialise.
2. If you have cold or flu symptoms call your doctor or Healthline and make sure you get tested.
3. Wash and dry your hands. Wash and dry your hands. Wash and dry your hands.
4. Sneeze and cough into your elbow, and regularly disinfect shared surfaces.
5. If you are told by health authorities to self-isolate you must do so immediately.
6. If you're concerned about your wellbeing, or have underlying health conditions, work with your GP to understand how best to stay healthy.
7. Keep track of where you've been, when and who you've seen to help contact tracing if needed. Use the NZ COVID Tracer app as a handy way of doing this.
8. Businesses should help people keep track of their movements by displaying the Ministry of Health QR Code for contact tracing.
9. Stay vigilant. There is still a global pandemic going on. People and businesses should be prepared to act fast to step up alert levels if we have to.
10. People will have had different experiences over the last couple of months. Whatever you're feeling — it's okay. Be kind to others. Be kind to yourself.

There are no physical distancing requirements at Alert Level 1. You can still play it safe by continuing to keep a distance from people you don't know, use your judgement. The more space there is between you and others, the harder it is for COVID-19 to spread.

KEEPING THE COMMUNITY WELL OVER THE COUGHS, COLDS & FLU SEASON

While general practice remains the right place to go if you are unwell, Central CBAC will remain in place as a drive through so that people can access support, clinical assessment and advice if people are unsure about the following:

- "I am worried I might have COVID-19"
- "I have a cold, cough or sore throat and I think I need some advice"
- "I have a cold, cough or sore throat and I need a medical certificate for time off work"
- "I need to be assessed so I can return to work after being home sick with a cold or flu"
- "Are my children well enough to go to school?"
- "I need some information to help me manage at home"
- "I need help to get connected with other services that will keep me well."

The drive through is FREE: it is run by registered nurses and is open 9am to 4.30pm weekdays. Please note medication will not be given and if you require further medical care the team will refer you to the appropriate place.

CAN I SEE MY HEALTH PROVIDER?

Yes - Health and disability services will be running as normal under Alert Level 1 but some precautions will still be in place to protect people who are vulnerable from exposure to the virus. Call us if you are unwell and we will discuss what your needs are and what kind of appointment will work best for you.

We are also swabbing for COVID-19 if you have relevant symptoms.

ARE HOSPITAL SERVICES BACK TO NORMAL?

Yes - Whangarei District Health Board health services are back to business as usual for the most part under Alert Level 1.

We want to remind people to keep up good hygiene like washing and drying hands, using the hand gel in our facilities and keeping a record of where you have been.

CAN I VISIT A FAMILY/WHĀNAU MEMBER OR FRIEND IN HOSPITAL?

Yes - Visitors are welcome in the hospital to see whānau and loved ones, but we still need to be cautious. Please don't come to the hospital if you are unwell.

Whangarei Hospital visiting hours are from 9am to 8pm, seven days a week. Please note: Contact tracing will be in place for Whangarei Hospital, Waimarino Health Centre and Rangitikei Health Centre.

CAN I GO TO ANTENATAL CLASSES?

Yes - classes will return to normal under Alert level 1, but hygiene measures will still be in place.

- The next available bookings for six-week evening classes is Monday 22 June
- Rapa Whānau Wānanga, one day class, Wednesday 24 June
- Individual one-on-one or small group sessions on Wednesday as requested.
- Distribution of Safe Sleep spaces; Popi Pōi and Mahakasa will also resume.

CAN I GET PARENTING AND BREASTFEEDING SUPPORT IF I NEED IT?

Yes - you can drop into any of the plunket rooms at any time.

Plus, Plunketline provides a free parent helpline available to all families/whānau and caregivers, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We also provide specialist breastfeeding support through video conferencing. Please give us a call on 0800 933 922. Calls are free from cell phones.

CAN I GO TO A PHARMACY TO GET MY PRESCRIPTION?

Yes - pharmacies are open for business as usual. Please be mindful of any restrictions they may still have in place.

CAN I ACCESS COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH, ALCOHOL & OTHER DRUG SERVICES?

Yes. Please pop in and complete a self-referral and we will make contact with you to see what your needs are and arrange an appropriate appointment. Alternatively, if you need someone to talk to urgently free text or phone 1737 anytime day or night.

CAN I GO TO THE DENTIST?

dentists are open and available for all appointments.

Please ring first for an appointment. If you urgently require a dentist in the weekend or on a public holiday, then phone the on-call dentist on 027 444 185. You will be seen between 9-11am.

CAN I SEE A PHYSIO, CHIROPRACTOR, OSTEOPATH, OPTOMETRIST OR PODIATRIST?

Yes. Give them a call to discuss what your needs are and make an appointment.

CAN I GET IMMUNISED?

Yes. Please check with your GP what immunisations you, your baby, your child and other whānau members are eligible for. It is important you all get Protected Together.

For childhood immunisation you can contact the Whangarei Regional Health Network Outreach Team on 0800 775 081.



CAN I VISIT SOMEONE IN AN AGED RESIDENTIAL FACILITY?

Yes - general family visits are allowed.

There may still be some restrictions on the number of family members visiting and frequency of visits. Please give us a call if you would like to check what guidelines are in place and what is expected of you when you arrive. Please stay home if you are unwell.

CAN I STILL GET SUPPORT IF I NEED IT?

Yes you can. To help support the community post COVID-19, a directory of support organisations and resources is available at www.wdhb.org.nz/wellnesssupport
