Rehearsal on the 3rd July at 3.30 to 4.30pm Juniors compulsory, seniors optional

SHOW TIME!

- The doors will open to designers and models at 5pm
- Safety briefing will be at 5.30pm
- Models from all sections must be ready by 6pm
- Show starts at 6.30pm sharp!
- Prize giving will happen after all of the sections have been seen, so you will stay in costume until the end of the show
- The children's section will run before the adult's section
 - ♦ Junior section A (year 4 & under)

 - ♦ Senior (year 9 & up)

MODELS

Please remember that this is not a static display and the goal of modelling is to bring your design to life! Please work with your model, share ideas on how to best present the work, think about movements that will enhance your work.

Your model will have several minutes on the stage. They do not want to be standing still all this time, be aware that "performance" will be taken into consideration during the judging and there is a prize for the "Best Performance" for each section.

If you have a particular look in mind for your models hair (excluding the hair section) remember this is to be your work also and up to you to create. Body paint is permitted.

If you need assistance in finding a model, let us know and we will help you.

You can enter both days.

All Junior competitors must be accompanied by an adult.

NOT ALLOWED:

- Pets
- Anything slippery or messy including unattached sequins
- Pyrotechnics, fire or water
- Real or realistic looking weapons
- Dry ice

PRIZES

- A performance prize for each section that goes to the model (junior & senior award)
- 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each individual sections
- Grand prizes for overall most points
- Peoples choice awards
- Sections have some additional awards

3rd JULY

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Costume, must be original and exclusive to the Wear-A-Bull Arts 2024 event
- Your garment must not be too heavy and needs to be safe for a model to wear and perform in
- All work must be the work of the competitors
- Your model must be able to get up and down stairs unaided while fully dressed
- Headpieces must be fitted, well balanced and allow the model to see clearly under stage conditions
- Your costume cannot have exposed wire or sharp edges that may damage/hurt your model, other contestants or their costumes
- Your entire costume/outfit (when on your model) must fit through a single standard door way 710mm wide x 1980 high and be no longer than 1 metre

Your costume's appearance **MAY NOT** be altered after the event has begun. It may be strengthened or made sturdy as long as the outward appearance stays the same.

- Only one helper per entry
- Only one entry per artist
- Only one model per entry
- Overall look is from head to toe
- All Junior competitors must be accompanied by an adult.

- Award for Junior A & B/Senior Textile (Construction & Innovation)

JUNIOR RECYCLED

OPEN TO YEAR 8 & UNDER ONLY!

Junior section A (year 4 & under) Junior section B (year 5, 6, 7 & 8)

(Judged separately)

Recycled art is creative work that's made from discarded materials that once had another purpose, take those materials and make them in to something new that you can wear.

- Design: Free to use recycled items as you want
- Materials: At least 80% recycled, 20% free use of materials
- Construction: Any form of construction is permitted
- **Description:** 50 word maximum description/inspiration to be given to the judges and read out by the MC during your model's parade



THE COLOUR GREEN OPEN SECTION

Explore the limits of your imagination, tell a story through your design and create something that challenges the conventional.

- Design: Must be completely GREEN
- Materials: Free use of materials as long as they are shades of GREEN
- Construction: Any form of construction is permitted
- **Description:** 200 word maximum description/inspiration to be given to the judges and read out by the MC during your model's parade



PLEATS & FOLDS

OPEN SECTION

Put your unique touch on the concept of a garment formed with pleats & folds.

• Design: Free style

Materials: Free use of materials

- Construction: Any form of construction is permitted. Pleats and folds need to be the dominant feature of your costume, it needs to have crisp, sharp lines and structure, this costume is not meant to transform or reveal. Keep your colour pallet simple
- **Description:** 200 word maximum description/inspiration to be given to the judges and read out by the MC during your model's parade



TWENTY ONE OPEN SECTION

Think completely outside the square in innovative fashion design to create a fabulous garment. Design with no limitations.

- Design: Your design must be based around 21 similar, recycled items/objects.
- Materials: Free use of materials
- Construction: Any form of construction is permitted
- Description: 200 word maximum description/inspiration to be given to the judges and read out by the MC during your model's parade

HAIR - 4th July

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- The hair style must be original
- All work must be the work of the competitors
- Your model must be able to get up and down stairs unaided
- Accessories and props must be fitted, well balanced and allow the model to see clearly under stage conditions
- Your entire costume/outfit (when on your model) must fit through a single standard door way and no longer than 1 metre
- No additional helper allowed, your model can assist
- Model can not be a competitor
- Only one entry per artist
- All capes to be removed prior to judging
- You will be supplied a table, chairs and power, all other equipment and products to be supplied by you
- Overall look is a head to toe finish
- Models are to be dressed all in black except for the bridal category
- All preparation IS NOT included in the one hour of competition, this includes any 3D art, props and accessories

- Art only on the day
- Overall look is a head to toe finish

- Pro over 3 years experience

All preparation is not included in the one hour of competition, this includes any 3D art.

Models to be dressed all in white!

- Design: To enhance the theme, is well thought out, must be complete & needs no improvement
- Originality: design to be innovative, unique and within the rules
- Visual: design to capture your attention, to hold your attention, to continue to draw your attention to new details
- Presentation: Entry is within category guidelines and presented as if it is not a special piece of art. Overall impression, workmanship, interpretation of the theme
- **Title:** Name and inspiration for your look to be given to the judges and be read out by the MC when modelling your final look







MAKEUP - 4th July

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- Your design must be original
- No additional helper allowed
- The model can not be competitor
- Only one entry per artist
- You will be supplied a table, chairs and power, all other equipment and products to be supplied by you
- Any 3D art can be made/brought prior to the event
- All base coats to be done prior to event start
- Art only on the day
- Overall look is a head to toe finish

- Design: Free style that fits the theme
- Materials: Free use of materials but the use of strip lashes must be included
- Construction: Any form of construction permitted
- **Title:** Name and inspiration for your look to be given to the judges and be read out by the MC when modelling your final look















BEST SPECIAL EFFECTS

OPEN SECTION

Competitors will have **ONE HOUR** to complete their look on the night. Start time to be confirmed.

All preparation is not included in the one hour of competition, this includes any 3D art, prosthetics.

Models to be dressed all in black!

- Design: Free style that fits the theme.
- Materials: Free use of materials but must use at least two different mediums (this could include but is not limited to: latex, silicone, wax, gelatine, foam, face and body paints, makeup, pros-aide or spirit gum, fake blood etc)
- Construction: Any form of construction is permitted

OPEN SECTION


Competitors will have **ONE HOUR** to complete their look on the night. Start time to be confirmed.
