


FROM THE Mayor's Desk

Kia ora koutou, The delivery of three waters services and roading contracts is performed by a shared service provided by Manawatu District Council in a relationship that has existed for many years. There has been a decision made by both councils to bring that relationship to an end. As of 1 July, Rangitīkei will be responsible for three waters and roading and the operators of our wastewater and water plants will transfer to being our staff. We absolutely welcome them as part of our team and their wonderful service will continue. Rangitīkei will inevitably need some assistance at senior levels or by way of outside assistance to transition this process. We believe that we need to be responsible for our own destiny and efficiencies which may come at a cost neutral or cost saving.



Cr Carter joined the Volunteer Fire Brigade 1970 and has served over 50 years for both Marton and Bulls brigades. He is currently Chief Fire Officer for Bulls Volunteer Fire Brigade. He is one of the many excellent volunteers we have throughout our district.

Lastly, I would like to acknowledge the recent passing of past Councillor Jim Howard QSM. It is appropriate that we recognise his involvement with Council over two terms spread between 1998 and 2004 as well as his wider community involvement. KINGS BIRTHDAY HONOURS **IUNTEE** Our very own Brian Carter has been recognised in the King's Birthday Honours list for services to Fire and Emergency New Zealand.

> Brian has been awarded a King's Service Medal (KSM) as the first member of the Bulls Volunteer Fire Brigade to serve for 50 years.

He has been the brigade's chief fire officer since 2006 and was deputy chief from 1991 until he was promoted. He first joined in 1970 and briefly, later in the decade, he served with the Marton Volunteer Fire Brigade before returning to Bulls in 1980.

During his long service, Brian has led the brigade through regular call-outs and several regional disasters. Brian served as a parent representative on the Clifton School Board of Trustees for three terms between 1991 and 2000. All the while, he has maintained his "day" job as a self-employed craftsman upholster based in Bulls Although he is now retired, he continues his craft as a hobby . Brian is serving his second term as one of two Rangitīkei District Council Southern Ward representatives after being re-elected unopposed in 2022. He wants to assure voters of his commitment to representing the area at the council table.

Born in Bulls, and married to Evelyn, they have 3 children and 2 grandchildren. Brian has also served the local community as a Justice of the Peace since 2016





Hope you all have a wonderful Matariki weekend and lets hope this weather remains so that we can see the stars over this celebration.




