



**Gifted Hands, by Ben Carson** read by Annabel Sidey Specialist in brain surgery on kids that are younger than 8.



- Individuals 65 years old and over
- People under 65 who have chronic long term health conditions and are vulnerable becoming very sick from the flu

This means that if you fall into either of these categories, you can receive the flu vaccine at no cost.
