Let's chat about parking on our main streets - it is like playing Tetris in real life!



Kia ora! Flu season is coming, Vaccines are available from the 2nd April 2024.

Pharmac Eligibility Criteria:

For the **2024 flu season**, the flu vaccine is **free** for the following groups:

- * Individuals 65 years old and over
- People under 65 who have chronic long term health conditions and are vulnerable becoming very sick from the flu

This means that if you fall into either of these categories, you can receive the flu vaccine at no cost.



Are you or someone you know due or overdue for your Cervical Smear? Have you heard about the new easy self swab? Come and see our friendly nursing team on Saturday morning to discuss this. We look forward to seeing you. Call reception to book an appointment on 06 3221222



Additional Information: If you don't meet the funded criteria, don't worry! You can still get a flu vaccination, but there will be a **cost** associated with it.
