





Puppies and Kittens

Notes from our Small Animal Vets

Puppies and kittens need proper care early in life to grow into healthy, well-adjusted adults. The first weeks are critical for development of immunity, behaviour, and social skills. Good nutrition using high-quality, age-appropriate food supports healthy growth, while orphaned animals require suitable milk replacers. Veterinary care, including health checks, vaccinations, and parasite control, is essential. A warm, safe, and clean environment helps young animals feel secure. Gentle handling, positive human interaction, and exposure to everyday sights and sounds encourage confidence and good behaviour as they grow.

Facial Eczema, Fly Strike, and Barber's Pole

Notes from our Production Vets:

Facial eczema, fly strike, and barber's pole worm are serious health issues affecting sheep and goats, particularly in warm, humid conditions. Facial eczema is caused by fungal toxins in pasture that damage the liver, leading to painful skin inflammation and permanent production losses. Fly strike occurs when flies lay eggs on dirty or wounded areas, with maggots causing rapid, severe suffering and possible death. Barber's pole worm is a blood-sucking parasite that causes anaemia, weakness, and death, especially in young animals. Prevention through pasture management, monitoring, hygiene, and timely treatments is essential to protect animal welfare and productivity.

Pre Purchase Inspections

Notes from our Equine Vets:

We have been flat out in the equine department with all manner of things – racehorses, sales yearlings and pre purchases in particular. Please, if you are looking at buying a horse, consider a pre purchase examination. This gives a thorough clinical picture of the horse you are buying with a full exam of all body systems including eyes, heart, lungs and legs. A basic two stage exam will include a trot up with flexions and lunging, while a five stage watches the horse ridden after the trot up portion, and repeats the exam afterwards to make sure nothing subtle arises. Additions such as xrays, endoscope and blood tests can be included. Different levels of exam suit different needs, but a baseline check over with a two stage is always a good idea to know that the horse you are buying is suitable for the job you want them to do.


