Providing our creative community with an opportunity to display their work is a fantastic way to encourage all forms of artistic expression and develops a space for art to thrive within and around the Rangitikei.

- All art work must be clearly labelled. Information should include artist name, contact information, title of work, medium, size and if for sale the purchase price.
- Art works must be light enough for one person to carry.
- All hanging art work needs to be no bigger than 1 metre wide to 1.5 long. Painting, Photography, Ceramic, Prints, Woven, Knitted, Quilted and Fibre so **let your imagination run wild.**
- The Hall will be open on Sunday the 12th of July from 10am to 5pm for artists to submit work. Please contact us to arrange an alternative time if the above times do not suit Your work will be hung by the Gallery Convenor and volunteers.
- Any sale of art work will be between the artist and purchaser.
- We will take every possible step to ensure that your artworks will be well looked after, the hall is alarmed after hours, however artists will be submitting work at their own risk. It is the artist's responsibility to insure their work for the duration of the exhibition and during transit.
- If you are submitting sculptural pieces, these can be submitted on Sunday the 12th too. If you require structures to support your sculptures, you will need to provide them.
- The exhibition will be open to the public from Monday 13th to Thursday 23rd July 2026, 10.00 am to 4.00pm daily.



- Your work may be used for advertising purposes or promotional material
- surrounding the Art 4 Arts Sake Exhibition.
- All wall art to be mounted must be strung and ready to hang.
- All art work is to remain on display for the full duration of the exhibition. Sold items are to be picked up after the exhibition closes.
- We would appreciate donations of time to run the Gallery from exhibitors. Telling the story of your art is empowering and people enjoy hearing your stories.
- During the exhibition we will be holding adult and children's workshops, if you would like to share your talents we would love to hear from you.
- If you would like to assist with the workshops or volunteer at the exhibition please fill in the section on the back at the bottom.
- All art is to be collected on Monday 15th July between 9am and 5pm. Please speak to the convenor if you need to make alternative arrangements.
