I also want to extend a huge welcome back to the marvelous Whaea Mel, who has hit the ground running, setting up an awesome new junior room and getting everything up and running for the year.


We are also very excited to see some huge improvements at school with our new fencing, making our school look amazing, and just around the corner we will be starting our field and turfed area upgrades.






